SCHEDULE OF OVERSEAS VOTING

To all overseas voters registered with the Philippine Embassy in Moscow, please note that **the casting of votes is suspended on April 18 and 19** in compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 555 declaring these dates as **regular holidays** in observance of Maundy Thursday and Good Friday.

We wish to remind everyone that you may still cast your votes from **April 13 to May 13**, **including weekends**, *with the exception of April 18 and 19*.

During this period, the voting precinct of the Embassy will be open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM to accommodate Filipinos <u>for casting of votes only</u>.

SUSPENSION OF PRINTING OF VOTER'S IDs

Please be advised that COMELEC has suspended the printing of voter's identification cards in view of the implementation of Republic Act No. 11055, otherwise known as "An Act Establishing the Philippine Identification System."
