OVERSEAS VOTING 2019:
**VOTERS REGISTERED IN ANY PHILIPPINE EMBASSY OR CONSULATE
MAY VOTE AT THE PHILIPPINE EMBASSY IN MOSCOW**

To encourage greater participation in this year's elections, COMELEC is allowing a voter who is registered in any Philippine Embassy or Consulate to cast their vote at the Embassy in Moscow.

This means that even if you are not registered with us or you registered but your name did not appear on our Certified List of Voters (CLOV), you can still vote here at the Embassy as long as your name appears on the CLOV of another Embassy or Consulate.

To vote:

1. Send a message to Philippine Embassy in Russia (@PHLinRussia) on FB with your name as it appears on your passport saying you are registered in another country but intend to vote at the Embassy in Moscow.
2. After receiving verification that you are indeed registered, appear personally at the Embassy or our remaining mobile voting sites (Yerevan and Yakutsk; please see advisory).
3. Inform Embassy officials that you are registered elsewhere and that you intend to vote.
4. Present your passport or any Philippine Government issued identification.
5. You will be given the form "Manifestation of Intent to Vote." Fill out and sign.

You will be given your voting packet and you may proceed to vote.

This COMELEC decision does not apply to postal voting as personal appearance is required.

ONLY ACTIVE OVERSEAS VOTERS will be allowed to cast their votes. Overseas voters who are not registered or whose overseas voter status has been deactivated by COMELEC will not be allowed to vote.
